VEHICLE OVERVIEW

This 1985 MCI Custom Coach 96A3 has a beautiful gray and blue custom paint job and almond, brown, and tan interior with light tan carpet/ceramic tile. Ride in style with electric pilot/copilot seats, air-operated step well cover, backup monitor, and a radar detector. You'll stay comfortable with over the road A/C, five elec heater with thermostat, thermopane windows, three Custom Coach/Copeland-zoned air conditioners, salon sleeper sofa, and 4-seat sleeper dinette.

Kitchen amenities include Corian countertops, custom tile backsplash, Norcold AC/DC refrigerator, convection microwave oven, four-burner cooktop, stainless steel sink, and trash chute to bin in bay. In the bathroom you'll find ceramic tile plus carpet w/runner, shower/tub combo, Microphor commode, and Corian countertops. There's plenty of entertainment options with a Sirius satellite radio, KVH in-motion satellite, Alpine dash sterio 2/6 CD player, Panasonic CD stereo in l ounger, CB, radio, and TVs in both front and rear. You'll find a queen bed in the bedroom and plenty of storage. The exterior of this 1985 MCI has a custom roof dec w/hatch access and safety rails, two air horns, emergency roof beacon, docking lights, backing lights, backup lights, electric heated mirrors, auxiliary radiator with water mist system, polished stainless side panels, and a custom paint scheme.

Under the hood this MCI Custom Coach is equipped with an Allison 5-speed automatic transmission, Detroit Diesel v92 (500 HP) engine, 12.5 KW Kohler diesel generator with 3,696 hours, 3 KW Honda Gas generator as backup, and Jacob's brake. You'll also find 150 gallon fuel capacity, 160 gallons fresh tank with 125 gallons grey/black tank combined, gray water bypass, 2 Shur-Flo water pumps, air operated dump valve, water faucet in bay, heated plumbing in bay, and an electric water heater. In addition there are storage drawers in bay, a Trace 4000W inverter, a Vanner 1500W backup inverter, a Vanner 12V battery charger, 6 deep cycle house batteries, and 2 8D chassis batteries. We will be replacing the tires on this coach.
